

# A Golf Expedition to Northern Ireland - 2018

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)



**What does the \$5,950 fee include?** With the exception of airfare, just about everything. Golf, caddies, meals, tips, transfers and tournament prizes are all included. A \$500 donation to New Life Ministries is also included in your fee (you will receive a \$500 tax receipt from your final payment).

**Are we to purchase our own airfare?** Yes. You should plan on booking a flight into the Dublin Airport (DUB), departing the USA on Saturday, April 21 for an arrival on Sunday morning, April 22. For your return flight, plan on booking a mid-morning flight home on Friday, April 27. Our resort is about 2 hours away from the Dublin Airport, so I wouldn't book your departure home too early. Further information will be provided after you register.

**When will we be back in the USA?** Our expedition will end Friday morning, April 27. With the time change, you should be able to be home that same night (Friday).

**I'm not a good golfer, will I be able to keep up?** Yes. Our golf format will be a handicapped system that will be competitive and fun for the low and high handicap golfer. Don't let your golfing ability deter you from attending.

**Will we be walking or riding for the golf?** On all courses, we will be walking and playing with caddies.

**What will be the tournament format?** We will be playing a modified Ryder Cup Team format for our competition. As a side note: This format will not interfere with individual play and each golfer will play five full rounds of his individual ball. **Describe the accommodations?** We will be staying at the spectacular oceanfront 5-Star Slieve Donard Resort in Newcastle, Northern Ireland. Unless you upgrade to a private room, accommodations are shared.

**What is the weather like in April?** April is a mild time of year weather-wise and late April is the start of their summer golf season. Temperatures will average around 57° in the daytime with an average evening low of 42°. April is actually one of the drier months with average rainfall of 2.0" (compared to 3.0" in July). This is Ireland golf, and the "weather elements" are part of the golfing tradition and experience. Preparation is the key to an enjoyable week of golf. All of our courses are on the Ocean with "weather" always being a possibility. We should always expect windy/breezy days.

**Are women allowed to attend?** This is a "guys only" trip. Our itinerary will keep us busy from morning until late evening. If your spouse would like to come, our suggestion would be to have her meet you after the event is completed.

**Can I bring my son?** Adult sons are welcome.

**Can I bring a guest?** Yes. This is a perfect format to bring a guest with you. This is designed to be a "friend raising" event for New Life Ministries. We would be thrilled to have your guest(s) join us.

**Is this a faith-based event?** Yes. We will have both morning and evening devotional sessions. Men of all faiths are welcome, and this would be a perfect opportunity to introduce a guy to a great group of Christian men.
