3. **Expected Household Chores:** _____ will be expected to do the following tasks to establish status as a contributing member of the household. In the event that a task is left undone, a verbal reminder will be given and the event will be documented. In the event that tasks are not done two weeks in a row, this contract becomes null and void and _____ may no longer claim residence at the address listed above if deemed appropriate by the homeowners. Owners reserve the right to give a monetary fine in place of eviction.
 - a. **Mow and edge lawn on weekends. (Or by Tuesday 7 pm should employment fall on a weekend.)**
 - b. **Responsible for removal of snow from walkway and driveway**
 - c. **Clean up materials used for cooking, rinse dishes, utensils and cookware and put them in the dishwasher.**
 - d. **Keep residence clean, free from dishes and debris.**
 - e. **Upon use of family vehicle, clean vehicle out and fill with gas when tank is below half a tank.**
